Welcome TO THE 2024 BIG RED BASH!

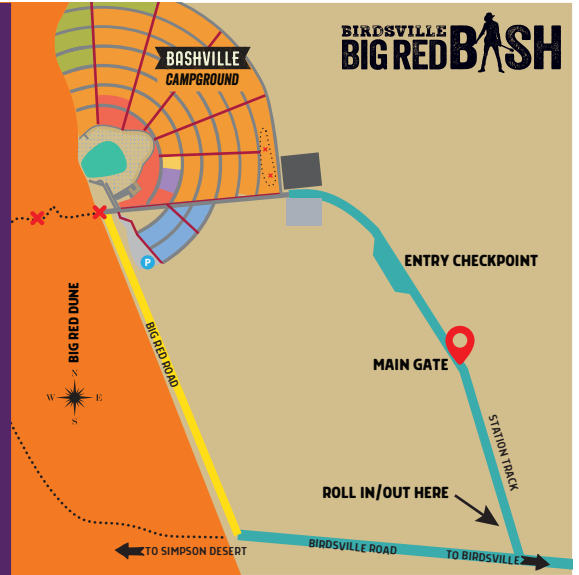
Over 4000 vehicles will roll into Bashville in only 4 days! Moving this many people into and out of Bashville is quite a feat!

Of course it will take some time, but with a little patience and by following some handy hints we'll make it as easy as it can be.

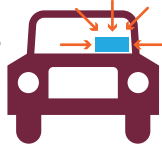

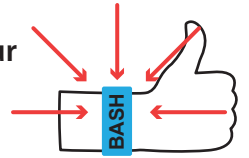
BEFORE LEAVING BIRDSVILLE

1 Affix vehicle stickers to passenger-side windscreen



2 Affix dog friendly campsite sticker if required

3 Put on your wristband

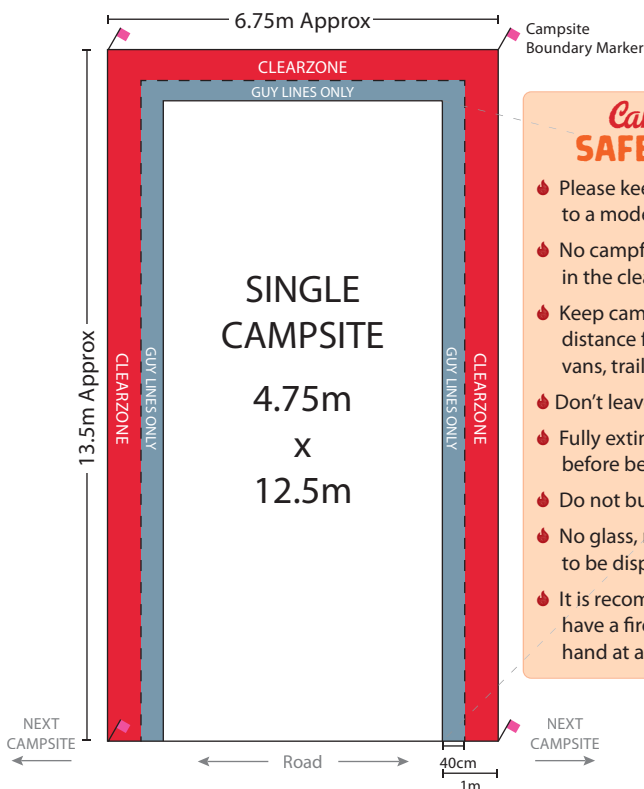


CHECK THE FIRESAFE CAMPGROUND LAYOUT MAP BELOW AND PLAN YOUR SETUP.

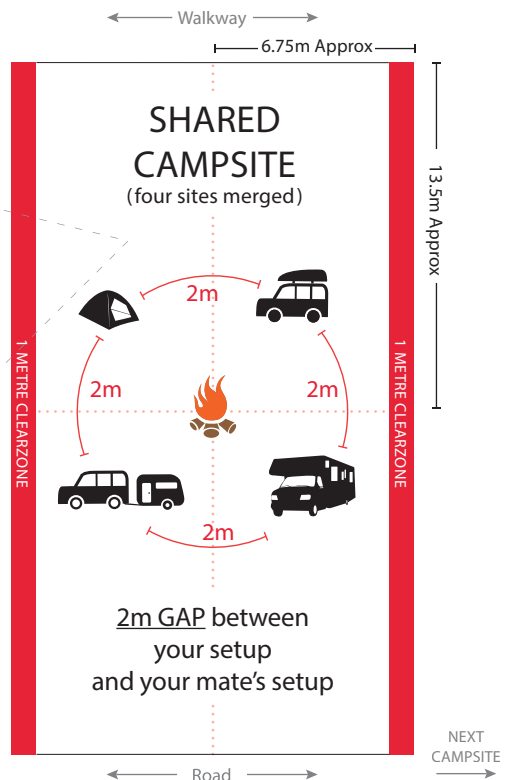
CAMPING WITH FRIENDS? Meet in Birdsville and roll in together.

No saving spots.

Yes **GROUPS** will be directed to adjacent campsites.



- Camp fire SAFETY TIPS**
- Please keep campfires to a modest size
 - No campfires permitted in the clear zones
 - Keep campfires a safe distance from vehicles, vans, trailers and tents
 - Don't leave fires unattended
 - Fully extinguish fires before bedtime
 - Do not bury fires
 - No glass, metals or plastics to be disposed of in fires
 - It is recommended that you have a fire extinguisher on hand at all times



GETTING TO BASHVILLE

- Choose the right roll in time for your ticket type.



ROLL IN 8AM - 6PM DAILY

ONLY TUE 2 - Roll In from 7am and join us for Big Blue Day

3 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Passfrom SAT 29

2 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Passfrom SUN 30

1 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Passfrom MON 1

STANDARD ENTRY TUE 2 (from 7am) & WED 3 (8am)

- Camping with a group? Travel in convoy – arrive together.
- Head west on Adelaide Street for 35km. Follow any special event speed limits.
- Road is fully sealed until turn off to Big Red Bash. Take care, expect a lot of traffic.
- Headlights on.
- No overtaking.
- Follow directions from road marshals.
- Expect delays of several hours at peak times.
- At the gate, tell marshals if you are rolling in with a group of two or more vehicles.
- **GATES CLOSE 6PM SHARP.**

GETTING TO YOUR CAMPSITE

- Stick to the Bashville speed limit. 10km/h minimises dust and keeps everyone safe.
- Our volunteer marshals will direct you to GENERAL, DOG or DISABILITY camping areas.
- Campsites are filled **from front to back.**



DURING THE BASH

- * Come prepared and plan to park up, kick back and relax for the whole Bash!

NO DRIVING IN BASHVILLE CAMP!

Need to leave the campground during the Bash?



If you have to go to town there's a transfer bus.



You can also drive out of camp **Sat 29 – Wed 3 @ 4 – 6pm ONLY** but you can't drive back in.



You must leave your car in **DAY PARKING** and walk back to camp.



Come and go from town to **DAY PARKING** 8am – 10pm.

Bring your car back to camp on **Thur @ 12.30 – 1.30pm.**

ROLL OUT

ROLL OUT need to know

- ➡ Roll out = 1 ½ days
- ➡ More than 60 volunteer road marshals
- ➡ Over 4000 vehicles leaving Bashville
- ➡ As campers pack up they need to join the line. Make room – there's no such thing as pushing in.

ROLLING OUT

EARLY EXIT Pack up and move car out of camp **Thur 4 @ 2–5pm**

GENERAL EXIT **Fri 5 @ 7am–6pm & Sat 6 @ 7am–Midday**

HOW TO AVOID TRAFFIC

- Early Exit Pass
- Stay an extra night
- Leave after peak-time (after 2pm)

DRIVING BACK TO BIRDSVILLE

- Expect delays.
- Don't overtake.
- Please observe road closures, changed speed limits and police directions.

ROLL OUT TRAFFIC GUIDE

THURSDAY 4TH

PRE ROLL OUT
12.30 – 1.30pm

Return vehicle from **DAY PARKING**: Bring your car back to your camp to pack and prepare for roll out.

EARLY EXIT
2pm – 5pm

Early Exit: Pass holders only. Expect minor delays – passes are capped but there are still a significant number of vehicles exiting. Passes \$15 online or at Merch tent, until sold out.

FRIDAY 5TH

PEAK
7am – 2pm

Peak time: Leaving early on Friday you can bet on getting stuck behind other drivers. Wait time of several hours. Please be patient. If you're not in a hurry wait for off-peak time.

SATURDAY 6TH

OFF-PEAK
2pm Friday – 12pm Saturday

Off peak: You might experience minor delays, but can generally expect less traffic.
